Gaining a Quiet Heart

Psalm 131:title-3 (NIV)

A song of ascents. Of David. 1 My heart is not proud, LORD, my eyes are not haughty; I do not concern myself with great matters or things too wonderful for me. 2 But I have calmed and quieted myself, I am like a weaned child with its mother; like a weaned child I am content. 3 Israel, put your hope in the LORD both now and forevermore.

Part One: The Author - David

David is a warrior king. He slew Goliath. Won Saul's daughter in marriage by defeating 200 Philistines. Fled from Saul. Established Israel as a military power. Captured Jerusalem. Moved the Ark of the Covenant into Jerusalem. Ruled Israel for over 40 years. Seventy-three of the Psalms are identified as David's. He was a warrior, poet and king.

Part Two: Calm and Quiet in the scripture

The scripture commands us to be silent:

Psalm 4:4 (NIV) 4 Tremble and do not sin; when you are on your beds, search your hearts and **be silent**.

Habakkuk 2:20 (NIV) 20 The Lord is in his holy temple; let all the earth **be silent** before him. Zephaniah 1:7 (NIV) 7 **Be silent** before the Sovereign Lord, for the day of the Lord is near.

Psalm 46:10 (NIV) 10 He says, "**Be still**, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth."

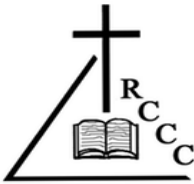
